We, Art Olympia Executive Committee will hold the second Art Olympia in 2017. Art Olympia is a new international open art competition held once in two years. The main goals are to discover young talented artists and to support them so that their global art careers may flourish. Art Olympia will give away a total of approximately \$500,000 in cash awards and prizes to 180 selected artists from all around the world.

Works to be Judged : 2-dimensional works

oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, mineral pigments, print, charcoal, digital/multimedia art, mixed media, photograph etc. calligraphy, video, sculpture, and group/collaboration works are not accepted

Process of Judgement : First round judgement by image and final round judgement by actual work.

Entry Period : to March 31, 2017

Student submission: one image for \$40, two images \$70, three images \$100

General submission: one image for \$60, two images \$100, three images \$140
